Chassis Removal Instruction:

Pull off knobs, then remove two 4BA screws at rear of chassis and the screws through the brackets on either side of the chassis (near the front). The chassis can then be withdrawn.

Access to the underside of the Record Changer is obtained by removing the record changer compartment back cover and releasing the transit screw retaining clins.

Cartridge loading is achieved by two 1000pF capacitors which are connected across each of the stereo outputs on the tag panel mounted on the changer.

N.B. Later versions will be fitted with a GP 81 P.U. cartridge, and the two cartridge loading capacitors deleted.
